ORDINANCE NUMBER 0-2020-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE O-2005-03 AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WARD TO ISSUE BUILDING PERMITS AND COLLECT FEES FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BUILDING PERMITS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES;

WHEREAS, THE CITY OF WARD, ARKANSAS (the" City") has adopted an Ordinance authorizing the issuance of building permits and collecting fees for such permits; and,

WHEREAS, as more and more structures (residential house and the like) are being built in this growing city, it becomes necessary to enact rules and penalties when a structure or other such activity identified in Ordinance 2005-03 Section 1 has commenced without first obtaining the proper permit.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WARD, ARKANSAS THAT ORDINANCE 2005-03 IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS;

SECTION 4: VIOLATION AND PENALITIES:

I. Stop Work Order Issuance:

- a. A Stop Work Order may be issued whenever work on any building or structure is being executed contrary to the provisions of the City of Ward Ordinance 2005-03, SECTION 1.
- b. Upon issuance of a Stop Work Order, <u>all</u> work shall be immediately stopped until a proper permit is issued.
- c. The Stop Work Order shall be in writing and shall be posted in a location clearly visible from the street accessing the property. Work crews on-site will be made aware of the Stop Work Order as well as the owner/developer if they can be located in a timely manner.
- d. The Stop Work Order shall state the violation and the conditions under which work will be permitted to resume.

II. Penalty:

- a. Anyone issued a permit after a Stop Work Order has been issued will be charged the normal fee for the permit PLUS an additional 100% penalty.
- b. Both the normal fee and penalty MUST be paid before the permit is issued.

SECTION 5 (ADDED): SEVERABILITY: If, for any reason, any portion or portions of this ordinance shall be held invalid, such invalidity shall in no way affect the remaining portions.
