

ORDINANCE No. O-2024-22

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CHRISTOPHER LEWIS, A CITY OF WARD EMPLOYEE, TO WORK AS A PAID UMPIRE FOR THE CITY WHILE OFF-DUTY FROM HIS NORMAL CITY DUTIES; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WARD THAT:

SECTION 2 - ACKNOWLEDGMENT: The Governing Body of the City of Ward hereby acknowledges that Christopher Lewis is a full-time employee for the City of Ward.

SECTION 1 – AUTHORIZATION: Christopher Lewis is hereby authorized to work as a paid umpire for the City of Ward Park and Recreation, while off-duty from his normal city position.

SECTION 3 – EMPLOYMENT STATUS AND TERMINATION: This Ordinance does not establish a contractual obligation with Christopher Lewis for umpiring duties, does not change is At-Will employment status of his full-time City position, and upon termination of his umpiring duties does not, in itself, affect his full-time employment status.

SECTION 5 – SEVERABILITY: If, for any reason, any portion or portions of this ordinance shall be held invalid, such invalidity shall in no way affect the remaining portions.

SECTION 6 – EMERGENCY CLAUSE: As the need to utilize Christopher Lewis as an umpire is needed immediately, an Emergency is hereby declared and this Ordinance is in effect upon passage.
